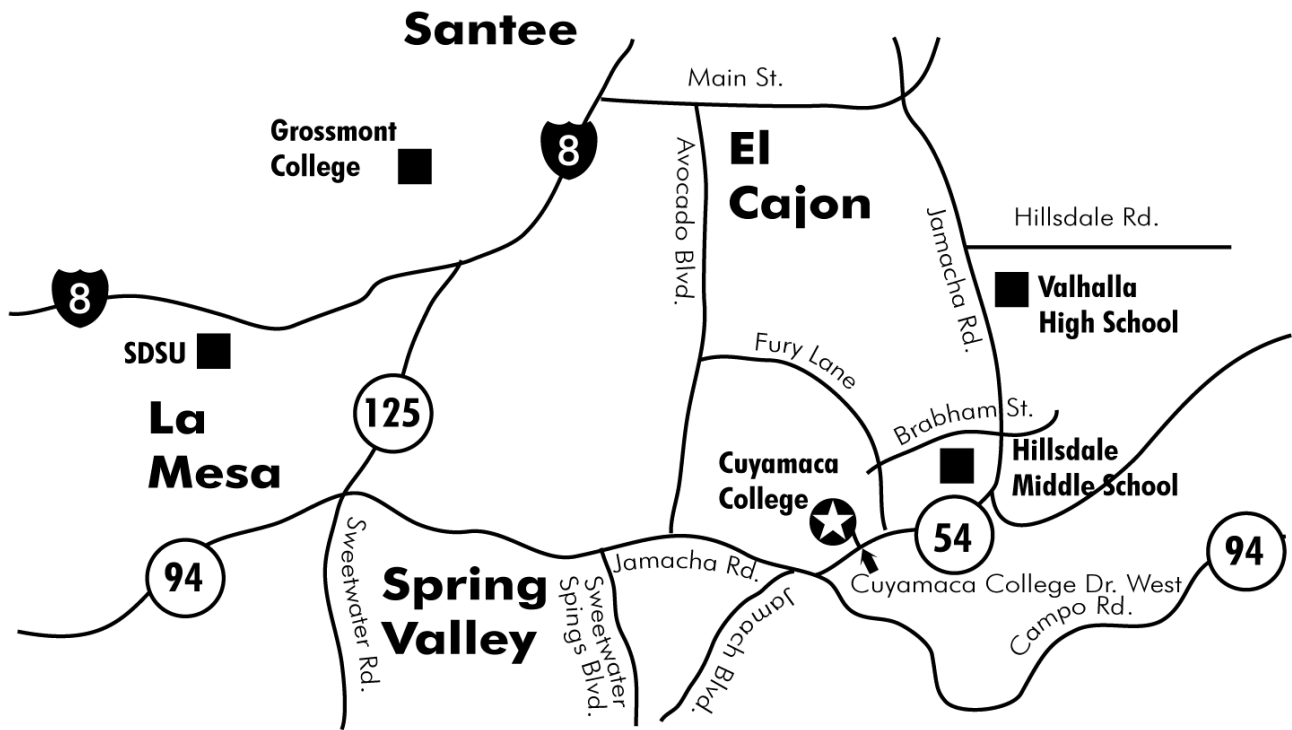

DIRECTIONS TO THE WATER CONSERVATION GARDEN AT CUYAMACA COLLEGE

Take Hwy 94 East past Avocado Blvd. in Spring Valley. Continue straight ahead to Cuyamaca College Drive West, which will be the fourth stoplight. Turn left. The garden will be on the right.
