About the Project: The San Diego County Water Authority will soon begin a water pipeline rehabilitation project near you. The project will rehabilitate several sections of large-diameter pipeline and related structures beginning just north of Highway 76 and ending near Highland Valley Road.

Much of the construction work will be underground and within Water Authority rights-of-way or within public streets.

This project will **not** interrupt water delivery to the area.
