Christy Guerin joined the San Diego County Water Authority Board in August 2014 representing Olivenhain Municipal Water District. Guerin is the Board Secretary and sits on the Imported Water Committee, the Legislation and Public Outreach Committee, the Colorado River Work Group and the MWD Settlement Negotiations Team.

Guerin served on the Encinitas City Council from 1998 to 2006, and as Encinitas mayor in 2002 and 2006. A 10-year veteran of the San Diego County Sheriff's Department, she also served as district director for U.S. Rep. Brian Bilbray from 2006 to 2011.

In addition, Guerin served on the SANDAG Board of Directors from 2000 to 2006; the North County Transit District Board of Directors from 1999 to 2004 and the San Elijo Joint Powers Authority Board of Directors from 1998 to 2002.

Guerin is a long-time Encinitas resident.
